

## **RESOLUTION 2011 -**

**WHEREAS**, Lake County recognizes its role in developing and maintaining regional relationships within the Central Florida Region; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County supports the development and use of Rapid Infiltration Basins in the Conserv II property co-owned by Orange County and the City of Orlando; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County supports collaborating with Orange County in jointly Master Planning the area that is generally south of Conserv II, east of Highway 27, north of 192, and follows the general path of the 429 in Orange County, including but not limited to the geographic area on the attached map; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County recognizes the area that is generally south of Conserv II, east of Highway 27, north of 192, and follows the general path of the 429 in Orange County, as an area containing ecologically sensitive lands including wetlands, and remnant sand hill and scrub communities; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County recognizes the area that is generally south of Conserv II, east of Highway 27, north of 192, and follows the general path of the 429 in Orange County, as an area rich in agricultural heritage; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County recognizes the area that is generally south of Conserv II, east of Highway 27, north of 192, and follows the general path of the 429 in Orange County, as an area that should be planned with future generations in mind to avoid piecemeal growth and suburban sprawl; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County recognizes the area that is generally south of Conserv II, east of Highway 27, north of 192, and following the general path of the 429 in Orange County, as an area designated for future economic opportunity including health and wellness and clean technology manufacturing; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County and Orange County have recreational and athletic and health and wellness facilities both existing and planned including but not limited to the National Training Center and the Horizons West Sector Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County recognizes that a bike and pedestrian trail way connecting Orange County to the Lake Louisa State Park would be beneficial to the economies of Lake County and Orange County and the health of the cities; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County recognizes an opportunity to jointly market with Orange County, the region, as a health, wellness and outdoor fitness corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County supports Orange County and Orlando Utilities Commission developing an Agreement with the City of Clermont to purchase reuse water; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County supports Orange County and Orlando Utilities Commission providing a long term agreement to provide for a Regional Park that Orange County has planned on the East side of the Conserv II property and at the same time Lake County is desirous of entering an agreement with Orange County and the City of Orlando to allow Lake County to utilize a portion of the Conserv II property on the West for park purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County supports Orange County and Orlando Utilities Commission providing easements for a future East/West connector between Highway 27 and the 429; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County supports Orange County and Orlando Utilities Commission providing easements for an extension of Hancock Road south to connect with a future East/West connector between Highway 27 and the 429; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, that:

**Section 1.** A copy of this Resolution will be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

**Section 3.** The preamble above is hereby adopted by the Board of County Commissioners.
