

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-97**

**WHEREAS**, on March 16, 2020, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County, Florida, declared a state of local emergency due to COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, by Executive Order Number 20-51 issued on March 1, 2020, the Governor of the State of Florida declared a state of emergency throughout Florida including Lake County, due to COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to protect the citizens of Lake County Resolution 2020-51 was issued on May 1, 2020, to provide protocols and guidelines for residents and businesses relating to the Governor's announcement of Phase I of the Plan for Florida's Recovery; and


**WHEREAS**, on May 31, 2020, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners issued an Emergency Curfew Order related to potential riots, vandalism, and looting within Lake County, Florida.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, I hereby find and declare:


1. Resolution 2020-51 shall be rescinded effective at 12:01 AM on June 5, 2020.


